

Thurleigh Castle, also known as Bury Hills, was a medieval castle in the civil parish of Thurleigh, in the county of Bedfordshire, England. It no longer exists at the current site; in 2005 it was moved to nearby Bolnhurst, on request of the parish council^[1], due in part to the overgrowth of *Heracleum mantegazzianum*, commonly known as giant hogweed, ^{[2][3][4][5]}.
