



Thurleigh Castle, also known as **Bury Hills**, was a [medieval castle](#) in the [civil parish](#) of [Thurleigh](#), in the county of [Bedfordshire](#), [England](#). It no longer exists at the current site; in 2005 it was moved to nearby [Bolnhurst](#), on request of the parish council^[1], due in part to the overgrowth of ***Heracleum mantegazzianum***, commonly known as **giant hogweed**,^{[2][3][4][5]}.
